Post-Draw Weigh-In is allowed only for athletes whose registration, identification and payments are **completely processed and verified prior to the day of the event. No applications are accepted or processing done on the day of the event. We **STRONGLY RECOMMEND TO REGISTER & WEIGH-IN AS PER SCHEDULE** time for your event. All pool sheets are drawn based on the completed registrations prior to the day of the event. **All that didn't make weight will be removed.***

Note: to assure undisturbed and prompt registration process and conduct of contests for both events, there will be **NO WALK-INS** allowed for either of the events. **Late fee of \$20.00 will be charged for all applications received after 04/01/2011.**

10. Rules:

The IJF rules current as of the events day govern the contests.

- **Teams, Seniors Elite, and IJF Juniors.** **WHITE** and **BLUE** Judo Gis are **strictly enforced**.
- **Juniors, Seniors Novice, and Masters.** **WHITE** and **BLUE** Judo Gis are **highly recommended**.

WARNING! All Judo Gis worn to a contest must be in accordance with IJF measurement rules. A Sokuteiki will be available for athletes to assure their Judo Gi meets the requirements. Athletes that come to the mat for a contest with illegal Judo Gi will be disqualified for that contest.

11. **Elimination:** Round Robin, modified double or single "Repechage at 8" will be used. *The tournament directors reserve the right to make any changes necessary to insure the safety of and fairness to all competitors.*



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12. Team Event Divisions: Seven (7) men with a minimum of five (5) men teams are required — one primary athlete per each weight category. Athletes must be born in 1996 or earlier. If your club cannot provide athletes for at least five (5) weight categories, you may choose to invite athletes from other clubs to create a team:

~~-60kg, -66kg, -73kg, -81kg, -90kg, -100kg, and +100kg.~~

NOTE FOR TEAMS ONLY: there will be an up to **2kg** weight allowance (e.g., if an athlete is up to 75kg at the time of weigh-in, he still can fight in -73kg if desires so).

From North: Take Triboro Bridge to Grand Central Parkway then to Long Island Expressway (LIE 495 eastbound). Then follow From Manhattan and Points West directions.

From South: Take Lincoln Tunnel to Manhattan then follow From Manhattan and Points West directions.

From Manhattan and Points West: Take Midtown Tunnel to Queens. Take the LIE eastbound; watch for Queens College signs. Get off at Exit 24 (Kissena Boulevard). If you want on-campus parking for the venue, watch for signs for Kupferberg parking as soon as you exit the LIE – do not go to the traffic light, instead take the first immediate right turn. If you need the main gate, after exiting LIE continue down the service road until the first traffic light (Kissena Boulevard). Make a right onto Kissena and the gate will be on your right side in the middle of the block.

From Long Island and Points East: Take the LIE (495) westbound; watch for Queens College (QC) signs. If you want on-campus parking for the venue, get off at Exit 23, turn left onto Main Street overpass. Watch for QC signs to Kupferberg parking. If you need to get to the main gate on Kissena, get off at Exit 24 (Kissena Boulevard). Make a left at the light and take overpass onto Kissena Boulevard.

I understand the nature of Judo activities and believe I am qualified to participate in such Activity. I also understand the rules governing the sport of Judo. 2. I further acknowledge that prior to participating, I will inspect the mats, equipment, facilities, competition pools or divisions, and the elimination or scoring system to be used, and if I believe anything is unsafe or beyond my capability, I will immediately advise my coach, supervisor, and/or a tournament official of such conditions and refuse to participate. 3. I acknowledge and fully understand that I will be engaging in a contact sport that might result in serious injury, illness or disease, including permanent disability or death, and severe social and economic losses due not only to my own actions, inactions or negligence, but also to the actions, inactions, or negligence of others, the rules of the sport of Judo, or conditions of the premises or of any equipment used.
